Ordinance 5 Series 2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF BUSINESS LICENSES

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek foresees a need to authorize business within the corporate limits of the Town of Coal Creek;

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek authorizes the Town Clerk or other authorized person(s), to create business licenses and to charge a business license fee for businesses operating within the corporate limits of the Town of Coal Creek, Colorado.

COTTAGE INDUSTRY: Anyone conducting any type of business from or in their home, shed, garage, commonly known as a “**Cottage Industry**” will be required to obtain a business license to be issued annually 12 months from the date first issued.

1. Cottage Industry is any relatively small scale business operation carried on in the home, shed, or garage, i.e., day care, beauty salon, tax service, craft items for sale, typing service, private investigator, etc. This is usually a business that does not necessarily show from the street or generate an unusual amount of traffic.

COMMERCIAL BUSINESS: Anyone operating a **Commercial Business** on their property that requires additional buildings, i.e., Body shop repairs, auto painting, boat building and repairs and by necessity accumulates equipment and has the potential to generate additional traffic in the neighborhood must obtain a Commercial Business License.

Business License fees are due annually 12 months from date of first issue:

1. Cottage Industry Business License Fee: \$15.00 annually
2. Commercial Business License Fee: \$50.00 annually

Sales tax will be paid to the Town of Coal Creek on a quarterly basis if and when they are instituted.

Any person or firm who operates any type of business within the corporate limits of the Town of Coal Creek and fails to obtain the appropriate business license will be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.
