ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LAW ENFORCEMENT, ADOPTING THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, ESTABLISHING FEES AND PENALTIES FOR NON-PAYMENT OF FEES WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF COAL CREEK, FREMONT COUNTY, COLORADO. ANY RELATED RESOLUTIONS AND/OR AMENDMENTS PERTAINING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

WHEREAS: The Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek recognizes that the Town is required to provide Law Enforcement for the residents as stated in but not limited to CRS 31-3-103; and

WHEREAS: the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek, desire a safe and secure community for all residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS; the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek, is committed to providing a higher level of service for the protection of person and property; and

WHEREAS; the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek, acknowledges that the Citizens of the Town of Coal Creek have made numerous complaints in writing and verbal, and have expressed concern in Public Meetings, and have requested extra police protection; and

WHEREAS; the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek has requested Police Protection from the City of Florence, Fremont County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS; the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek has agreed to provide this and has adopted the Model Traffic Code For Colorado,

THEREFORE; BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF COAL CREEK, FREMONT COUNTY, COLORADO, that;

1.) Authorization is hereby granted to the City of Florence to provide Limited* Police Patrol and Law Enforcement within the town limits of the Town of Coal Creek. This shall be in effect until, by written notification, one party renders it ineffective.

2.) The Model Traffic Code of Colorado is hereby adopted,

3.) Limited* shall mean what the Town of Coal Creek can afford or what the City of Florence can provide.

4.) The fees set forth for this service shall be billed on a monthly basis to all water users within the Town of Coal Creek until such time funds can be secured by other means. This fee will show on the "Town Bill" that is sent monthly, typically called "The Water Bill".

5.) The "Town Bill" is required to be paid by the 25th of each month, whereupon that bill becomes overdue and a \$10 (Ten Dollar) Late Fee is applied. Penalties for non-payment of the "Town Bill" has been provided for in Resolution No. 5 - Series 2015 and shall be in force for all payments on the "Town Bill".

6.) Fees and other future adjustments will be made by Resolution.


