**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF
COAL CREEK**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wish to have the employees, officers and board members conduct town business without fear for safety, or fear of retaliation, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees establish the following for all personnel doing business on behalf of the Town of Coal Creek:

1. In addition to the powers and duties set forth in town ordinances, every officer, employee, board member or other person doing business as or for the Town of Coal Creek shall exercise all of the powers and perform all of the duties provided for, by the Law and by any Ordinances of this town.
2. If any person shall resist, delay or obstruct any officer of this Town in the performance of any duty or in exercise of any power conferred by Law or by any Ordinance of this Town, every such person on conviction shall be fined not less Than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each offense.
