

RESOLUTION NO. 5 – SERIES 2019

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ENTERPRISE FUND FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek desires a safe and secure community for all its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS. The Town of Coal Creek is committed to providing a higher level of service for the protection of person and property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek acknowledges that the Citizens of the Town of Coal Creek have made numerous complaints in writing, and have requested Police Protection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Coal Creek has requested Police Protection from the City of Florence, Fremont County, Colorado; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems it necessary to charge a fee that will be called Law Enforcement Fund, an Enterprise Fund which by definition is a fund that provides goods or services to the public for a fee; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF COAL CREEK, FREMONT COUNT, COLORADO, that:

Authorization is hereby granted for the Town to initiate and bill each household in the town limits a minimum \$10 (Ten Dollar) monthly fee to be used only for the purpose of providing as many hours of Police Enforcement as affordable.


The Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines and declares that this Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of public welfare, health and safety.
